INFRASTRUCTURE

How will your internal IT staff maintain your system infrastructure if they are required to work remotely?

MINIMIZE DISRUPTION

Could you maintain your necessary “uptime” to minimize any disruption to normal business operations?

CONTINGENCY PLAN

Does your managed services provider have a proven contingency plan to effectively service your business if they need to work remotely?

INVENTORY

Do your hardware providers have sufficient inventory and ability to ship any necessary equipment on a timely basis?

AUTOMATION

Have you automated repetitive tasks that do not really require a human?

CYBER RISK

Do you have a plan to boost your security screening anticipating scammers will play on employee anxieties and increase your cyber risk?
